
Here is an overview of our application process

4	If your application is successful, we'll send you an Offer Letter and an Acceptance Form.			
5	Complete your Acceptance Form and return it to us to secure your place.			
6	We will enrol you. Once you are enrolled, we will send you a confirmation letter and a statement of fees.

I further acknowledge that MIT may withdraw my enrolment from a course where I have not attended in the first three weeks.
